



## Guam Swimming Federation Guam B Championships MEET RULES

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VENUE:	Hagatna Swimming Pool, Hagatna, Guam
COURSE:	Long Course, 50 Meters (Up to 7 lanes)
SCHEDULE:	Warm ups: 7:30 am; Races Start: 8:30 am
RULES:	The meet will be conducted in accordance with current FINA swimming rules. This is a Guam Swimming Federation Event. Failure to comply with competition rules may result in scratch or disqualification from an event.
FORMAT:	Timed finals format for all events.
TIMING:	Semi-automatic timing system (auto start, 2 button finish) with manual backup.
DIVISIONS:	<u>Individual Events:</u> 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18, and Open <u>Relay Events:</u> 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 and Open (same & mixed gender)
ELIGIBILITY:	All athletes must be currently registered with their governing FINA Federation. Age on the first day of competition will govern a swimmer's eligibility for any age group category.
DEADLINE:	Entries must be received no later than Friday prior to the meet. No late entries will be accepted at the meet. Entries must be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager. Please e-mail entries to: Rita Jugo at <a href="mailto:ritacjugo@gmail.com">ritacjugo@gmail.com</a>
ENTRIES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• "NT" entries are not permitted.</li><li>• Athletes must be entered with their best time in the conforming course.</li><li>• No swimmer may enter an event if their best time is an "A" time as established by the Guam Swimming Federation.</li><li>• The Guam 17-18 age group time standards are used for the Open Division.</li><li>• <u>Limit:</u> Swimmers may enter a maximum of five (5) individual events and one (1) relay.</li><li>• <u>Procedures:</u> All required files for entries must be e-mailed NO LATER than the entry deadline. Entries must be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager.</li></ul>
ENTRY FEES:	\$5.00 per swimmer per individual event and \$7.00 per swimmer per relay.
CHECK-IN	Check-in sheets, including scratches, are due to the Clerk of Course by 8:00 am. A Coaches' meeting will be held 15 minutes before the end of warm ups.
WARM-UPS:	Teams will be assigned lanes by the Meet Director. Pool will be cleared 15 minutes prior to session commencement. Swimmers must have a deck coach to participate in Warm-up. During the meet a cool down/Warm-up lane will be on an "as available" basis.
AWARDS:	High point medals will be awarded to the top 3 individual point scorers in an age group. Relays will not be scored.
RESULTS:	Results will be posted at: <a href="http://www.guamswimming.org">www.guamswimming.org</a> Hard copy of meet results will be provided if possible. Results will also be e-mailed to coaches no later than Sunday, May 6, 2018.
TEAM ASSIGNMENTS:	Teams are responsible for providing 1 contributing adult for every 4 swimmers entered. "Contributing" is defined as a person that can fulfill a position such as timer, official, referee, marshal, computer operator, etc. Teams failing to provide the appropriate number of meet support staff may be subject to disciplinary actions and/or fines.
